SAGINAW, MI – January 18, 2018: Admission-free field trips for schools, as well as agencies serving vulnerable youth, can be scheduled today! Sponsored by local foundations and businesses, these field trips allow our community's youth to explore the ten interactive STEM-rich galleries of the Mid-Michigan Children's Museum at no-charge.

Second grade students will learn the unique properties of air and water while enjoying gallery-play during *2nd Graders Are 1st Class* field trips. The STEM-based experiments with the museum's air and water exhibits align with Michigan Common Core standards and cannot be duplicated in a classroom setting. Any public, parochial or charter school within Bay, Midland and Saginaw counties can schedule its admission-free second grade field trip today! **Full-admission and limited transportation scholarships** are generously provided by Frank N. Andersen Foundation, Dow Corning Donor Advised Funds, William F. McNally Family Foundation, Allen E. and Marie A. Nickless Memorial Foundation, and Wickson-Link Memorial Foundation.
