



# STAY HEALTHY WHILE YOU PLAY

At the Mid-Michigan Children's Museum, the health and safety of our community, guests, staff, and volunteers is our greatest priority. In response to COVID-19, we have implemented the following enhanced measures:

**Cleaning:** We practice thorough cleaning procedures every day at MMCM, not just during flu season or when illness strikes our community. We also do an extensive cleaning on Monday's, when our museum is closed to the public. We are taking extra precautionary measures in light of COVID-19 and routinely disinfecting commonly touched surfaces throughout our facility. Disinfecting wipes and sanitizers are also available for use around our museum.

**Hand Washing:** We have extra signage posted throughout the museum and in restrooms to remind all visitors and staff to wash their hands frequently and thoroughly. Extra hand sanitizers are stationed throughout the museum, as well.

**Sick Policy:** MMCM works to provide a safe and healthy environment for all visitors and staff. We request that staff and visitors avoid coming to the museum when sick or showing signs of illness. A general rule to follow is that if you or your child is too sick to go to work or school, you should not visit the museum.

**Staying Connected:** We are following and implementing the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) guidelines and Michigan Department of Health and Human Services updates, information, and recommendations. We are continuously monitoring our local emergency management agencies and other peer institutions as we proceed with activities.
